Purpose: To promote the full, conscious and active participation of the faithful in all liturgical celebrations so they may “comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ and be filled with all the fullness of God.” (Ephesians 3:18-19). Firmly rooted in sacred scripture and the teachings of the Church, this series will provide a comprehensive introduction to liturgical principles and practices through selected readings, lecture and discussion and individual projects. Practical application will be emphasized.

Session 5: March 3: The Joy of the Gospel: Sacraments at the Service of the Church & the World
