Due to COVID-19, safety measures to protect our processing staff have slowed the handling of gifts received by check.

Please reassure parishioners who ask about the status of their donation that acknowledgments are going out weekly and their check should be deposited soon.

### Email going to Parishioners in the next few days.

Typically in June, direct mail goes to past donors who've yet to donate in the current year. This year, an email will also go to everyone whose email is on record, including those who've already given this year. Because our charities have expressed tremendous gratitude for Appeal funds, which allow many of them to quickly mobilize in response to disasters like COVID-19, email and direct mail will encourage donations and thank donors for their part in ensuring our charities are ready and able to respond. Unlike many other funding sources, Appeal grants can be used for the greatest need.
