RE: California Office of Emergency Services grant opportunity for non-profit organizations

The California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) received an award of \$7,020,630 to fund security improvements for non-profit organizations from the Department of Homeland Security (DHS). \$5,670,460 will be available to organizations in the State's Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) regions with the remaining amount (\$1,350,170) allocated to counties that do not fall into a UASI. For the purposes of the Sacramento Diocese, parishes and schools in Sacramento, Yolo, El Dorado, and Placer Counties are in a UASI while all others are not.

This is one of two annual grants funded by DHS for non-profit security improvements. The application process for these grants is exacting with grants moving forward through a competitive process only if they meet Cal OES and DHS requirements.

To assist organizations interested in applying, Cal OES has scheduled four webinars to provide critical information. The webinar dates are September 2, September 4, September 8, and September 10. I have attached the Cal OES grant management memo outlining these webinars.

The California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES), Grants Management, is pleased to announce the FY 2020 NSGP Required Documents Webinars.

Cal OES received the FY 2020 NSGP award from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security in the amount of \$7,020,630. Of the \$7,020,630, \$5,670,460 is awarded to the NSGP-Urban Area, and \$1,350,170 is awarded to the NSGP-State. The [FY 2020 NSGP Allocations](#) are available on the Cal OES website.

To ensure funds are spent pursuant to the intent of the grant, Cal OES will conduct webinars to relay programmatic requirements for the FY 2020 NSGP. The webinars will cover topics such as new requirements for FY 2020, how to avoid common mistakes, instruction on the required documents submission process, and procurement technical assistance. A representative from each nonprofit organization must attend this webinar. A lack of attendance may lead to an increased risk of noncompliance with grant requirements.
