## What is a novena?

The word "novena" is derived from the Latin word for nine, or "novem." Typically, a novena refers to nine days of prayer, asking God for a specific intention, often through a Saint's intercession. Novenas are a beautiful way to grow purposeful, consistent, and persistent in daily prayer.

Our Diocesan Respect Life Novena is dedicated to those babies who have been aborted, for those mothers who have suffered a loss of a child, and mothers in need.

## How to Pray a Novena?

Step 1: Make the Sign of the Cross

Step 2: Pray for the intercession of the day

Step 3: Our Father, 3 Hail Marys, Glory be

Step 4: Pray the closing prayer and prayer of

the Young Saint card

Step 5: End with Sign of the Cross


