General Summary

What is the primary purpose of this position?

The Learning Support Specialist at St. Francis Catholic High School provides instruction and program planning for students with learning differences as well as students in the general population who need academic support. This role researches, obtains, and provides professional development for faculty/staff members at St. Francis Catholic High School; serves on Student Support Teams (SSTs); serves on the Academic Advisory Council; creates Formal Education Plans and monitors distribution; proctors final exams in Alternate Test Site; and promotes the St. Francis Catholic High School mission and philosophy of inclusion.

Essential Responsibilities

List all major job functions performed on a regular basis.

All areas of responsibility must be operated consistent with the Catholic mission of the school.

- Evaluate incoming students and identify candidates for summer intervention program; manage the caseload of students identified as needing additional support (1:1, meeting with teachers to develop plans).
- Provide instruction, monitor and evaluate student progress, and research and obtain instructional materials to support students with diagnosed learning differences.
- Research and publish Best Practices Manual; research and provide professional development to St. Francis teachers; research and coordinate instructional interventions for students with learning differences.
- Participate in SST meetings, collaborate with Support Services including Guidance and Wellness Departments; answer concerns expressed by team members; write academic support plans.
- Attend and contribute to Formal Education Plan and Medical Support Plan meetings; create Formal Education Plans in accordance with psychologist recommendations and approved SF Checklist of Interventions; create Medical Support Plans in accordance with practitioner's recommendations, coordinate distribution of FEPs to support team members; coordinate final exams Alternate Test Site.
- Manage accommodation requests for college entrance exams.
- Create a transition plan from middle to high school and from high school to collegiate study.
- Research college support services for students, and develop student support materials.

Master's degree or Teaching Credential in Special Education required. Current California licensure is also required.
