Re: Guidelines for hosting parish healthcare fairs

Dear pastors, parochial vicars, administrators, deacons and parish staff,

Church parishes may find the need to, as part of community-outreach, to sponsor health fairs where attendees can learn about health resources or receive low level medical services (i.e. vaccinations). This is often to help people that lack such information or access to services due to economic and cultural barriers.

The following are guidelines that should be followed to minimize liability and ensure conformity with Church teaching.

- No healthcare provider or vendor may be present if the provider's business in any way promotes or provides abortion, contraception, euthanasia, or other actions contrary to Church teaching. This is even if the provider provides other legitimate, moral healthcare services.
- Outside groups/vendors involved in healthcare events on parish grounds must be vetted by the Office of Catholic Charities & Social Concerns prior to publicizing the event (contact info listed below).
- Outside group/vendors providing health education or medical services on parish premises need to
 provide a Certificate of Insurance (COI) showing they carry the required insurance limits for <u>General</u>
 <u>Liability</u>, <u>Automobile Liability</u> and <u>Workers Compensation</u>. In terms of the General Liability coverage, the
 parish and diocese should be named as an additional insured for the event. Additionally, they should
 carry and provide proof of <u>Medical Malpractice</u> coverage.
- The parish should also obtain a **Facility Usage Agreement** (FUA) signed by the clinic provider/group representative (attached).
- Church representatives, whether paid or volunteer, should not themselves offer healthcare screening, diagnostic advice, or related services.
