Subject: Mandatory Anti-Sexual Harassment Training Laws

It is required by law for all employees to complete the mandatory California Anti-Sexual Harassment training every two years. All non-supervising employees are required to take a one-hour training while supervisors are required to take a two-hour training. All employees in the Diocese of Sacramento must complete the required training this year. If the employee has not completed their training in 2021, then the employee must recomplete the training. The Diocese of Sacramento renewal training will be completed every odd year.

All school employees will have from 8/1/2021 - 9/30/2021 to complete this training. This training is done through CMG Connect. You can log in to your account or create an account if you are a new user by clicking the following link <a href="https://sacramento-schools.cmgconnect.org/">https://sacramento-schools.cmgconnect.org/</a>. Once logged in, please follow the instructions below to complete the supervisor training.
