JOB SUMMARY: The Coordinator of Youth Ministry supports the mission of the Elk Grove Youth Ministry (Good Shepherd, St. Maria Gotretti & St. Joseph Parishes) under the direction of the Director of Youth Ministry Director to recruit, train, empower and inspire teams of paid and unpaid youth ministers at Good Shepherd, St. Joseph, & Maria Gorretti Parishes in Elk Grove, to make young disciples of Jesus Christ, by providing comprehensive ministry to youth age 11-17 with the goal improving parish participation of youth, and fostering vocational discernment. Job requires weekend and evening work. Sunday is a full regular weekday.

Leadership Development / Vocational Discernment

- o Provide on-going orientation, training, support and resources to paid youth ministers
- o Provide on-going orientation, training, support and resources to volunteer youth ministers
- o Provide monthly training, planning and support gathering for all youth ministry leaders.
- Close collaboration with vocations promotion
- Collaborate with priests and religious communities to promote vocations and increase interaction between teens and clergy, seminarians, women in formation, and religious.

Program Development

- Develop a variety of youth group gatherings at each parish with programming offered several times per week and publish a monthly calendar of Catholic youth events for the City of Elk Grove
- Provide quarterly outreach event to all teens in the city of Elk Grove

- o Provide five scheduled office hours each week at all three parishes and three hours at the mission.
- Meet monthly with Diocesan Regional Coordinator for Youth & Young Adult Ministry.
- o Offer parent formation at least four times per year in collaboration with parish formation staff.
- Meet monthly with Youth Ministry Board and parish staff teams
- Provide a quarterly report to priest deanery meeting.
- o Provide an annual report to each parish pastoral council
- Partner with parents and families of youth
- Establish an active presence for the ministry on Instagram, Facebook and the web.
- o Use digital tools to spread the word to teens and their families via Direct Message, text, etc.
