Re:	Free Webinar – Employee Vigilance Strategies and De-escalation Techniques

CISA, the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (part of the Department of Homeland Security) is offering a one-hour webinar covering violence de-escalation techniques and methods to encourage employee vigilance. The webinar is part of CISA's efforts to promote programs that help non-profit and critical infrastructure organizations lower the chance that they become the target of violence.

The webinar provides an overview of CISA's "The Power of Hello" and "OHNO" (Observe, Initiate a Hello, Navigate the Risk, and Obtain Help) programs that are designed to help employees and volunteers recognize and address behaviors that might indicate criminal or violent intentions and stabilize potentially threatening encounters. These are simple but effective concepts I recommend to church and school employees and volunteers in all the vulnerability assessments I write and present.

The webinar is scheduled for Wednesday, March 30 from 10:00 – 11:00 AM. The program is offered on HSIN Connect (Homeland Security Information Network), which uses the Adobe Connect platform.
