INTERNSHIP INFORMATION

Who? Any U.S. Catholic with an interest in solidarity building, participation of the poor, and Catholic social teaching.

What? The CCHD intern will work with the Office of Catholic Charities and

Social Concerns to support environmental justice projects. Tasks would include: Outreach to parish ministries and other faith-based communities to conduct a series of leadership development. Work with clergy and parish leaders to provide education, resources, and training focus on *Laudato Si'*. Plan activities to engage parishes, schools and other faith base communities to pray, learn and act in response to *Laudato Si'*. Internships are paid at a rate of \$15.00/hour.

Where? Diocese of Sacramento; local parishes, Diocesan schools and other faith-based communities in the low-income communities in the Greater Sacramento Area.

When? Internship is offered during Summer, Fall or Winter. Must attend the National Intern Orientation on June 1-3, 2022 in D.C.

Why? To support this important ministry of the Church while building professional skills and relationships.
