JOB SUMMARY: Perform routine cleaning and maintenance work in/on all parish and school buildings and grounds under the guidance of the Plant Manager.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: Apply the professional skills and knowledge of specialized field to perform work without specific directions using considerable judgment.

General Responsibilities:

- Sweep, scrub, wax, or polish concrete, linoleum, tile and wood floors
- Vacuum rugs and carpets in school offices, faculty rooms, classrooms, gymnasium, library, recreation rooms, auditoriums, dining room, cafeteria and hallways as needed or assigned
- Clean and dust walls, furniture, woodwork, and other equipment in all areas
- Pick up refuse on grounds and sweep walks and entrances
- Wash, scrub, and disinfect restrooms
- Clean windows, door glass, and drinking fountains, clean and polish metal work such as door panels and hand railings
- Empty and clean waste and recycling containers
- Move or rearrange chairs, tables, desks, furniture, and other equipment
- Replace light globes
- Make minor repairs or adjustments to classroom furniture
- Maintain equipment used in the course of work
- Report safety, sanitary and fire hazards
- Cut and trim grass and shrubs; water lawns and shrubs as needed or assigned
- Supervise students during lunch and recess times
- Supervise the clean-up of lunch areas
- Supervise the playground so that students play in a safe manner within the assigned areas
- Perform related duties as required
