Through relational ministry, retreats, small group discipleship and outreach events, the Youth Minister will work alongside our Pastor and Director of Evangelization and Catechesis to spread the Gospel and make disciples.

Location:

Amador County is in the heart of the Gold Country and is known for its natural beauty. Alongside the historical mining towns that are scattered throughout the area, there are miles of hiking trails and beautiful lakes to explore. Mixed in with the history is a rich wealth of local wineries. Many move to Amador County to get away from the busyness of the Bay Area and to enjoy the small town life.

Middle School Youth Ministry

Initiate and build a community of faith, with Middle School youth, in accord with the Parish Mission. This group meets at the parish on a least a monthly basis.

Argonaut and Amador High School Catholic Clubs

Facilitate and teach at bi monthly meeting and provide short evangelistic/catechetical content. Support and develop youth leaders and bridge to parish youth group.

High School Youth Ministry

Initiate and build a community of faith, with High School youth, in accord with the Parish Mission. This group meets at the parish on a weekly basis.

Confirmation Program

Coordinate and build the Confirmation program for 7th and 8th grade students.

Young Adult Gatherings

Build and coordinate gatherings of Young Adults and increase general engagement in the community.

Recruit, train, and support youth, young adult, and adult volunteers to assist in Youth Ministry.
