In the cover story of this issue, readers meet Dusty and Stephanie Machado, owners of Machado & Sons Dairy in Elk Grove. They and their daughters, Hayden and Daphne, are members of St. Joseph Parish in Elk Grove. They committed to revitalizing the family dairy legacy first started by Dusty's grandfather in 1958. "I can't imagine how it would be if I didn't believe in God," Dusty says. He adds that he is 100 percent convinced that his strength and his ability to cope with all the stressors of agricultural work in California stem from his faith and trust in God.
