

ENDOWMENT

Provides support to the works of your choice by producing a steady income stream in perpetuity

CHARITABLE REMAINDER TRUST (CRT) Cash or property in a trust that makes payments for your lifetime or

a number of years, then passes what remains to the parish or works you designate

IRA CHARITABLE ROLLOVER

Those 70½ or older can direct IRA distributions to various diocesan ministries, including your parish




