## DAY 1

---

*Intention:*

For mothers facing unexpected pregnancies.

*Scripture:*

“Then the angel said to her, ‘Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name him Jesus.’” —*Luke 1:30-33*

*Prayer:*

God, we ask you to be with every expectant mother. Give them the courage of Mary to say yes to your divine will, even in the most unexpected circumstances. Help us to notice women in need and embrace every mother facing an unplanned pregnancy. Amen.

## DAY 2

---

*Intention:*

For fathers to have the courage of Joseph.

*Scripture:*

“When Joseph awoke, he did as the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took his wife into his home.” —*Matthew 1:24*

*Prayer:*

Lord, thank you for the example of Joseph, who shows us what it means to live with courage in the wake of fear and uncertainty. Bless all fathers with the strength of Joseph so that in every circumstance they may place their trust in you. Help all fathers to answer the call of sacrificial love that comes with the birth of every child. Give them the strength to be not afraid. Amen.

## DAY 3

---

*Intention:*

For couples suffering from infertility.

*Scripture:*

He will be filled with the Holy Spirit even from his mother’s womb, and he will turn many of the children of Israel to the Lord their God.’” —*Luke 1:13,15-16*

*Prayer:*

Our Father in heaven, we pray in a special way for all those who struggle with infertility. We ask you to give them peace in their suffering, strength in their perseverance, and healing in body and soul.

In the midst of sorrow and uncertainty, fill them with your joy so that, as Romans promises, they “may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.” We ask this in Jesus’s name. Amen.

### *Intention:*

For parents to experience the joy of every child, including those with disabilities.

### *Scripture:*

### *Prayer:*

Lord, help us renew our gratitude for the joy that each child brings into our lives. Help those who are close to expectant mothers to offer the compassionate care that Elizabeth’s friends did throughout her pregnancy. Help us never to close our eyes to women in need. Amen.

## DAY 18

### *Intention:*

## DAY 20

## DAY 31

Lord, teach us how to suffer alongside you. Grant us the joy of your company under the wood of the cross. Grant us the strength of Simon to help you on your way. We unite every tired step and discouraging defeat to your sacrifice for the redemption of all humanity. Amen.

## DAY 35

---

*Intention:*

God, we ask that those who have participated in abortion will know that your mercy does not expire. Help us to forgive as you do so that others might come to understand the dignity of every human life, including their own. Convert the hearts of abortionists. May they experience your forgiveness as Dr. Bruchalski and so many others have. Amen.
