Re: Emergency Preparedness and Targeted Violence Response Training

The Central California Intelligence Center (CCIC) is offering another one-day emergency preparedness and response to targeted violence training class. This class will be presented in Grass Valley on Saturday, October 5, 2024 from 8:00 AM – 3:00 PM.

This is a live presentation covering active shooter behavior and responses, “SWATTING” incidents, and “stop the bleed” tourniquet application training. As with previous classes, participants receive a Combat Application Tourniquet (“CAT”) tourniquet upon class completion.

Sal Cortez, the class instructor is a retired CHP sergeant with decades of law enforcement and EMS experience and has responded to two different active shooter incidents.

The class is free but space is limited. The class location will be provided to attendees after successful registration.
