The following are other tips and ideas for you:

- 1) Holy Hour for Vocations during National Vocation Awareness Week: We encourage Parish Vocation Committees to organize a Holy Hour for vocations for the youth at your parish with the support of your pastor. - 2) Rosary for Vocations: We encourage Parish Vocation Committees or religious education programs and youth ministry to organize these.
- **3) Priests,** this is an opportunity for you to share your vocation story. Young people love hearing, why you are a priest!
- **4) Prayers of the Faithful (USCCB):** You may include the following intentions in the prayers of the faithful:
  - For young people in our community that they may respond generously with open hearts and willing spirits if the Lord calls them to the priesthood, diaconate, or consecrated life.
  - For men and women to be open to God's call to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ as priests, deacons, or consecrated persons.
