JOB SUMMARY: Coordinates Religious Education and Sacramental Preparation for the parish including the HSPS. Develops and maintains a youth ministry program. Develops and forms an outreach to the young adults in the parish.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: Maintains programs which meet the needs of the youth in the parish, both school and CFF students under the guidance of the Pastor and Parish Manager.

CFF PROGRAM

- Responsible for scheduling catechetical staff, maintaining and communicating lists of volunteers, and submitting schedules of church activities for inclusion in the Master Calendar.
- 2. Schedules and adjusts program components including but not limited to: location for program, class times, and materials needed.
- 3. Supervise volunteers as needed for parish projects and liturgical activities approved by and under the supervision of the Pastor and Parish Manager.
- 4. Responsible for coordination of special liturgical celebrations
- 5. Ensures all baptismal and other sacramental certificates are collected at the beginning of each new for all new students
- 6. Accurately and neatly records sacraments received in the appropriate sacramental register.
- 7. Ensures that all teachers and aides are following the pastor-approve curriculum.
- 8. Ensures all teacher, aids and parent chaperones are fingerprinted and have completed Safe Haven training before volunteering.
- 9. Other duties as required.

- 6. Maintains a ministry of presence among the youth.
- 7. Plans, coordinates and implements occasional weekend retreats and evenings of prayer.
- 8. Coordinates participation in regional, diocesan, and national activities.
- 9. Maintains necessary records of activities in youth ministry.
- 10. Other duties as required.
