Re: FY 2024 NSGP grant application webinars

CalOES has scheduled several webinars to assist interested non-profit organizations with the application process for the FY2024 federal non-profit security grant program. This grant appears to be different from the previous federal grant since it allows organizations to act as a "consortium" and make multiple applications for affiliated facilities. The "consortium" or group application is not a requirement however so organizations can still make individual applications.

The grant offers a total of \$210 million to non-profit organizations nationwide, with half dedicated to facilities in an "Urban Area Security Initiative" (UASI) and the remaining amount to facilities outside of a UASI. For the purposes of the Sacramento Diocese, churches and schools in Sacramento, Yolo, El Dorado, and Placer Counties are in a UASI region and all others are not.

This announcement was sent last week, so two webinar opportunities have passed. The remaining webinar dates are Tuesday November 19 and Wednesday November 20. Interested organizations are strongly urged to participate in one of the presentations. **This grant application window closes at 11:59 PM on December 11.**

Subject: Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 Nonprofit Security Grant Program-

National Security Supplemental (NSGP-NSS) Application Webinars

The Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency announced the FY 2024 NSGP-NSS in the amount of \$210,000,000, available nationwide for nonprofits. Of this amount, \$105,00,000 is available to nonprofit organizations located in designated urban areas (NSGP-NSS-UA), and \$105,00,000 is available to nonprofit organizations located outside designated urban areas (NSGP-NSS-S).

The NSGP-NSS is focused on physical/cyber security, and facility/target hardening of nonprofit organizations' facilities at risk of a terrorist of other extremist attack. Nonprofit organizations that are eligible under the FY 2024 NSGP-NSS are those organizations that are described under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and exempt from tax under Section 501(a) of such code.

In preparation for the FY 2024 NSGP-NSS application submission, Cal OES will be conducting webinars to explain the requirements and application process.

Only electronic submissions will be accepted. Proposals received after Wednesday, December 11, 2024, 11:59 PM PDT or received in any other email address will not be considered. Incomplete, scanned copies, altered or prior versions of required forms, combined IJ and VA Worksheets, or embedded links of application documents will not be considered. Please ensure that your Application package email submission is accurate and complete before sending. Resubmission or duplicate proposals will also not be considered.
