Re: January 22nd - Day & Mass of Reparation

January 22 marks the anniversary of the lamentable 1973 U.S. Supreme Court Decision, Roe v. Wade. While Roe was overturned in 2022, **Proposition One was passed in California, embedding the practice of unrestricted access to abortion in our State Constitution.** Recognizing the sin of legalized abortion still afflicting the people of California, in the Diocese of Sacramento, <u>Bishop Soto has designated January 22nd as a Diocesan Day of Reparation. All are asked to observe this Day of Reparation through fasting, prayer, penance and works of mercy.</u>

Bishop Soto has designated January 22nd as a Diocesan Day of Reparation for the 1973 passing of Roe v. Wade. All the faithful are asked to observe this day with fasting, prayer, penance, and works of mercy.
